

Château Cos Laborry

2023 Saint-Estèphe Appellation, Classified Fifth Growth in 1855

Cabernet Sauvignon 55%, Merlot 33%, Petit Verdot 8%, Cabernet Franc 4%

Michel Reybier and his family open a new chapter of the history of Château Cos Labory, classified a Fifth Growth in 1855, in Saint-Estèphe.

Sitting upon the hill of Cos, the terroir of Cos Labory is situated on its plateau of deep gravel, with its clay and limestone base, benefits from the nearby Gironde estuary and the influence of the Atlantic Ocean temper extreme weather conditions.

The 35-hectare vineyard is made up of several islets, three of which form the historic heart at the top of the plateau, with the oldest vines giving birth to the Grand Vin, Château Cos Labory.

On whole, the vineyard, aged 38 years old on average, is planted half with Cabernet Sauvignon, a third with Merlot and a small proportion of Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot.
